UPDATES TO RULES AND GUIDLINES

The following changes to the Maricopa Live Steamers Railroad Preservation Society Other Rules, Guidelines, and Schedules - Revised February 2023, were voted on and approved at the November 11, 2023 BOD and General Meeting.

MLS Other Rules, Guidelines & Schedules revised February 2023

Changes to December 2023

Under 350. Storage Requirements

356 Letter M verbiage will now become letter N Letter M will now read as.

M. Each storage container owner must furnish a key or the combination to any lock affixed to their container to the treasurer to facilitate periodic inspections by The Maricopa County Parks Department and Maricopa County Flood Control inspectors .The MLS inspection committee will conduct inspections to ensure that all storage containers and cabinets comply with the rules outlined in section 356.

N. The intent of this rule is to be applied to all privately owned storage, containers or buildings along the railroad or on the end of any steaming bay.

Add 357

357 Procedure for non compliance of Rule M

A. The owner will be notified by email and telephone, by their information indicated on their current membership form, requesting a response within Ten days of notice.

B. Those members who do not respond by providing a key or combination within ten days will be mailed a certified return receipt letter requesting a response within Fifteen days of receipt.

C. In the event of no response, MLS will take further steps to contact a responsible party. During this time, MLS will remove the current lock and inspect the interior and correct any violations if needed. The container will then be secured with a lock provided by MLS. A notice will be affixed to the container informing the owner to contact any Executive BOD member to gain entry. Executive BOD member contact information will be included on the notice

Forceful removal of any MLS lock will result in permanent termination from MLS.

This procedure will also be used to address "Abandoned Property"
